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I read over your reply regarding my post about screwing Colin's DMSA dosage (or so I thought-you said I actually came close to getting it right by accident!). According to the DAN protocol he would be taking 150 mg every 8 hours but I had been giving him 50 mg every 8 hours instead. Just a little background for you: Colin is a 39-40 pound 39 month old. He has received 6 rounds of DMSA and has steadily improved in all areas. Yeast is a huge problem for us and he is on Diflucan indefinitely for the next few months. He has blood drawn every 30 days to insure proper liver function-so far, so good. Even with the last dosage of DSMA increased to 150 mg, he tolerated it very well. He has very high levels of lead on top of the mercury problem. So far, in his urine tests the lead is there. The mercury is much slower to pull (but we expected that).

1. How much DMSA does he need every 4 hours?

25 mg.

2. What are the benefits of giving it every 4 hours as opposed to 8 hours?

Dramatically more rapid improvement and less yeast problems.

3. Will this harm him by my changing his dosage this frequently (50 mg, up to 150 mg, back down to \_\_\_)?

No.

4. What risks/harm do you feel can come from the 8-hour dosage?

More mercury is forced into the brain and immune system and liver, and it is hard to remove it later. This makes therapy take a lot longer and be a lot harder on him.
